Webinar on the Union, States, citizens

The Francophone University Center of the University of Szeged is organizing, in cooperation with the European Public Law Organization (EPLO), a webinar on "The Union, States, Citizens" on Wednesday, September 22, 2021.

The event will take place at 3 p.m., online, under the high patronage of László Trócsányi, Member of the European Parliament, former Hungarian Minister for Justice, Professor and Professor Spyridon Flogaitis, Director of EPLO. Speeches will also be offered by Mr. Prokópios Pavlopoulos, former President of the Hellenic Republic, professor, by Mr. Jean-Pierre Raffarin, former Prime Minister of France, Mr. János Martonyi, former Minister of Foreign Affairs of Hungary, professor emeritus and Mr. François-Xavier Bellamy, member of the European Parliament. Mediation will be provided by Mr. Gergely Fejérdy, Deputy Director for Scientific Affairs of the Otto Habsburg Foundation, Associate Researcher at the Institute of Foreign Affairs. The conclusions will be presented by Mr. Péter Kruzslicz, Assistant Professor, Director of the Francophone University Center of the University of Szeged.

The Conference on the Future of Europe, which was officially launched on May 9, 2021, offers the opportunity for a free but also responsible global reflection. This webinar, organized by the Centre Universitaire Francophone, is part of this discussion. Europe is more than a geographical space, it is, above all, a space of civilization and culture which has yet to be reinvented within the framework of the Conference. The challenges, from a political and legal aspect but also in view of the global social and economic context, of such a reinvention are numerous.
