Second scientific advisory council at EPLO Cascais

The second meeting of the Scientific Advisory Council of the EPLO's Regional Branch was held on 2 July at the Casa de Santa Maria in Cascais, Portugal. The annual meeting of the Scientific Advisory Council of the EPLO'S Regional Branch brought together the President of the Scientific Advisory Council Professor Jose Manuel Sérvulo Correia, its members - Professor Luis-Maria Diez-Picaso, Professor Spyros Vlachopoulos, as well as Professor Rui Lanceiro, Ambassador of Greece to Portugal Ioannis Metaxas, Representative of the Municipality of Cascais Teresa Violante, and the EPLO's Director Professor Spyridon Flogaitis.

During the meeting, a number of important issues were discussed, such as the further promotion and development of the EPLO's relations with the Community of the Portuguese-speaking countries (CPLP) and the Ibo-American countries (SEGIB), EPLO's collaboration with Brazil, the EPLO's participation in the UN Ocean Conference in Lisbon, and the preparatory work for the organization of the EPLO's annual international conference, among other topics. The Scientific Advisory Council's meeting was followed by lunch at the Cascais Marina.
