EPLO 's Side Event for the Global Rule of Law Commission at United Nations Headquarters in New York

On **November 14**, the **EPLO** hosted a prominent side event at the United Nations Headquarters in New York titled "**Feasible Reforms to Strengthen the UN on behalf of the Rule of Law.**" The event was co-sponsored by 18 Member States, showcasing broad international backing. The co-sponsors included **Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cape Verde, Costa Rica, Cyprus, Georgia, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Moldova, Mozambique, Portugal, Romania, Thailand, and Ukraine.**

The event brought together a distinguished panel of experts and officials **Prof. Larry D. Johnson**, Former Assistant Secretary-General for Legal Affairs at the United Nations, **Ambassador Andreas Mavroyiannis**, Facilitator of the 61st UN General Assembly on equitable representation and Security Council reform and, **Mr. Miguel Ángel Moratinos**, Under-Secretary-General and High Representative for the Alliance of Civilizations, contributed as a participant.

The keynote address was delivered by **Mr. Giuliano Amato**, President of the Global Rule of Law Commission, former President of the Italian Constitutional Court, and former Prime Minister of Italy. His speech underscored the urgency and feasibility of reforming key UN mechanisms to better uphold and promote the Rule of Law on a global scale.
