Conference on "The timeless message of the Constitution of Trizina"

The **European Public Law Organization (EPLO)**, in collaboration with the [Law School of the European University Cyprus](#), held a scholarly conference titled "**The Timeless Message of the Constitution of Trizina**" on **Friday, 23 May 2025**, at the EPLO premises in Plaka (Dioskouron and Poikilis Square, opposite the entrance of the Roman Agora).

This conference explored the enduring legacy of the **Constitution of Trizina (1827)**, a foundational moment in Greek constitutional history, through historical, legal, and political analysis.
