Chisinau, Moldova: the second Branch is located in Moldova with headquarters in Chisinau at the premises of the University of European Political and Economic Studies (USPEE). Ms. Iryna Zhenchak was seconded from the Office of Planning, Budget and Accounts Controller (OPBAC) to continue her service for one year at this Branch and was appointed as its first Director, representing the EPLO, supporting all EPLO-USPEE activities and EPLO projects in Moldova, and looking for new opportunities for EPLO and USPEE in Moldova and the region.

Yerevan, Armenia: in December 2013, the EPLO established a Branch in Yerevan, Armenia. The branch was officially inaugurated on December 17, 2014.
