Event on the mapping of the Greek Justice System

The EPLO's Institute for Justice and Growth is organizing an event on the subject "The mapping of the Greek Justice system; European Experiences - Current Situation - Proposals for Reform" at the EPLO premises in Plaka, on Thursday 28.09.2017 at 18:00.

The Working Group dedicated on the subject will present the findings of its research.

After the presentation of the survey, the Professor of Constitutional Law at the Law School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Mr Georgios Gerapetritis, will provide a critical review on the findings of the study which will be followed by an open discussion.
