Ronny Abraham re-elected as Judge of the Int'l Court of Justice

We are happy to announce that the General Assembly of the United Nations has re-elected yesterday Ronny Abraham as Judge of the International Court of Justice. Ronny Abraham (France), has been a member of the International Court of Justice since 15 February 2005, was re-elected as of 6 February 2009 and has served as President of the Court since 6 February 2015. He is a long standing member of the European Group of Public Law -the Scientific Council of the EPLO- as well as former Member of its Board of Directors.

Born in Alexandria, Egypt, he holds a degree in Advanced Studies in Public Law from the University of Paris I and a degree from the Institut d'études politiques of Paris, where he was also a professor of international law until 1998.
